Dear Parent/Guardian and Staff of Esterhazy High School,

The Saskatchewan Health Authority (SHA) advised Good Spirit School Division that additional positive cases of COVID-19 have been diagnosed in individuals at **Esterhazy High School**. In collaboration with SHA, GSSD has determined that the school will move to remote instruction.

All **Grade 6 to 12 classes** will be **cancelled on Tuesday, December 15, 2020**, which will allow the teachers to finalize preparations for the change in instructional delivery to remote learning.

Mandatory remote learning will take place on **Wednesday, December 16, 2020 to Friday, December 18, 2020**. Families will be contacted prior to Wednesday with details regarding the delivery of instruction and materials, by Esterhazy High School staff. Students will **tentatively return to school on Monday, January 4, 2021**, based on the advice of the Local Medical Health Officer.

Public Health will continue contacting parents/guardians of students and any staff/visitors/volunteers who may have been in close contact with the cases and will provide direction.

If you or a family member would like to be tested for COVID-19, you are encouraged to access the drive-through testing at 276 Myrtle Avenue in Yorkton. You may be tested without an appointment between the hours of 1:00 pm - 3:00 pm, seven days a week, or you may call 8-1-1 for a referral and an appointment will be scheduled for you.


Public Health has organized a drop-in testing site at the S.N. Boreen Community Center in Esterhazy on the following dates:

- **December 29, 2020 from 10:30 am to 4:30 pm.**
