Dear Parent/Guardian of Math 9 Student,

During the evening of February 11th, the Saskatchewan Health Authority (SHA) advised Good Spirit School Division that an individual at Yorkton Regional High School has tested positive for COVID-19. The individual was in your child's Math 9 class (Room A7) during the morning of February 3rd.

Public Health will be contacting parents/guardians of students and any staff/visitors/volunteers who may have been in close contact with the case and will provide direction.

Public Health strongly recommends that your child be tested for COVID-19. They may be tested without an appointment at 276 Myrtle Avenue in Yorkton, between the hours of 10:30 am – 3:30 pm, seven days a week, or you may call 8-1-1 for a referral and an appointment will be scheduled for you. Ensure that you have your Health Card with you. Children under the age of 18 will need verbal consent from a parent or guardian.

Public Health encourages all students and staff to remain at home when showing the slightest symptom of COVID-19.
