On February 15, 2021, you were made aware that an individual in the Grade 3 classroom at Yorkdale Central School had tested positive for COVID-19. At that time, all classes for Grade 3B and Grade 3F moved to mandatory remote instruction. I am pleased to announce that Public Health has confirmed that both Grade 3 classes will resume to face-to-face on Monday, March 1, 2021.

Upon return to school, staff and students will continue to follow the GSSD health and safety guidelines, including wearing masks, following hand hygiene practices, and physical distancing.


