Dear Parent/Guardian,

GSSD and Davison School Administration met with Public Health to review the Grade 6 (601) return to school date. I am pleased to announce that Public Health has confirmed that **face-to-face instruction will resume on Tuesday, May 4, 2021. Individuals who have been directed by Public Health to remain at home and/or deemed a close contact, must follow their direction.** If your child borrowed a device, for remote learning purposes, please return the device to the school on Tuesday.

The SHA would like our help with continuing to do our part in stopping the spread of COVID-19 by following Provincial regulations and encouraging all students and staff to remain at home when showing the slightest symptom of COVID-19. There is a COVID-19 testing site available at the Horizon Credit Union Centre in Melville; you may access the drive-thru testing site on Monday afternoon from 1:00-3:30 pm. Drive-thru testing is also available at 276 Myrtle Avenue in Yorkton between the hours of 8:30 am – 3:30 pm, seven days a week. You may also call 8-1-1 to schedule an appointment. When you attend your appointment, ensure that you have your Health Card with you. Children under the age of 18 will need verbal consent from a parent or guardian.

We would like to assure you that the GSSD facility disinfecting and cleaning protocols have been and will continue to be followed but as an extra precaution, the GSSD Facility team will fully disinfect the entire school building.
