Dear Parent/Guardian,

GSSD and Canora Composite School Administration met with Public Health to review the Grade 5 to 12 return to school dates.

Public Health has confirmed that **face-to-face instruction may resume on Monday, May 10, 2021**, with the **exception of Grades 5A, 8A and 8B**. If your child borrowed a device, for remote learning purposes, please return the device to the school on Monday.

Grades 5A, 8A and 8B classes will tentatively resume face-to-face instruction on Monday, May 17, 2021. Families will receive confirmation of the return to school date on Friday, May 14, 2021, following the COVID-19 review meeting with Public Health.

The SHA would like our help with continuing to do our part in stopping the spread of COVID-19 by following Provincial regulations and encouraging all students and staff to remain at home when showing the slightest symptom of COVID-19. There is a COVID-19 testing site available at 276 Myrtle Avenue in Yorkton. You may be tested without an appointment between the hours of 8:30 am – 3:30 pm, seven days a week, or you may call 8-1-1 for a referral and an appointment will be scheduled for you. You may also go to the COVID-19 testing site at the OCC Hall located at 407 Park Street in Kamsack, Monday to Friday from 9 am – 3:30 pm. Ensure that you have your Health Card with you. Children under the age of 18 will need verbal consent from a parent or guardian.
