

SUPPLEMENTAL LEARNING PLAN GRADES 10 - 12

DISTRIBUTED LEARNING COURSES

MARCH 31 - APRIL 3

Online teachers will contact students/families to communicate student grades in each course they are enrolled in.

Online teachers will determine:

- Whether or not the student is auditing a course
- Whether the student is requesting on-going summative assessment
- Whether the student is discontinuing study

Audit

A course audit allows students to accept their current mark as of March 13, 2020. This allows continued access to course content without further assessment/teacher interaction

On-going Summative Assessment

This involves a student continuing their studies with on-going assessment to June 26, 2020.
Student final marks will not be lower than the mark achieved as of March 13, 2020.

Discontinuing Study

This involves a student discontinuing the learning within a course they are currently enrolled in and accepting a final mark as of March 13, 2020.

Students Auditing Courses

Students will be expected to submit any outstanding work as of March 13, 2020 to ensure marks are current and up to date

Students will be given continued access to their online courses for independent study.

(students are not required to submit assignments and teachers are not required to support these students through tutorials, zoom meetings, or on-going assessments)

Students Choosing Continuous Assessment

April 1

Students will continue learning through the Moodle platform

Students will have access to teacher contact through zoom - hours will be communicated by classroom teachers

Assessment will be on-going through this time
