Attention NASP Archers & Families:

This year the National Archery in the Schools Program will be holding the Canadian National Tournament prior to the Saskatchewan Provincial Tournament.

The reason for this is because NASP wanted to have the National Tournament during the Edmonton Boat and Sportsmen Show (Mar. 12-15<sup>th</sup>)

Provincials will be held in Avonlea, SK on April 24<sup>th</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup>.

Due to the distance and cost involved, CCS & CJES will not be able to cover any of the costs involved with the National Tournament. Costs to interested families would include a \$25 tournament registration, travel, accommodations, meals, etc.

Archers can shoot as individuals, but if we have 12 archers in a Division we can qualify as a team. A Team can consist of a minimum of 12 archers and a maximum of 24 archers. Team Configurations are as follow:

Grade 4 & 5 – Elementary Division

Grades 6 to 8 – Middle School Division

Grades 9-12 – High School Division

We have currently Pre-Registered 7 students from Grade 5, 12 students from Grade 6-8, and 2 students from Grade 11. On February 2<sup>nd</sup> at 2:00 pm Registration opens whereby flight times (shoot times) can be picked. We will be trying to get the Friday, March 13<sup>th</sup> at 2:30 shooting time but there are no guarantees.

If you are interested in coming to Nationals please let Mr. Lowes or Mr. Steciuk know ASAP. Once an archer is registered for a shooting time on Feb. 2<sup>nd</sup> they must commit to the \$25 registration fee.
