School Community Council Structure:

Five to nine parent and community members, two high school students, the principal, one teacher, and the representative Board of Education member.

Student Demographics:

K-12 school, 199 students

School Programs and Services:

- Staff – 16 teachers (13.53 FTE) and 8 support staff members.
- Churchbridge School offers all of the Required Areas of Study and has an active band program. Students from CPS and surrounding communities have an opportunity to take pure Millwright 10, 20 & 30, the first of its kind in Saskatchewan. Senior students are transported for general Industrial Arts classes and Calculus 30. A Distributed Learning initiative will be piloted in the 2014-2015 school year.
- Students have access to computer technology and instruction. Staff is supported by a technological staff member, regular meetings with an Educational Technology Coordinator and access to Network Technicians.
