## **Registration Procedures for September 8-11**

**Sept. 8 – Last names A-F** students register in their homerooms. **Please bring your EHS and EMBI fees. Fees are due today**

**Sept. 9 – Last names G-M** - students register in their homerooms. **Please bring your EHS and EMBI fees. Fees are due today**

**Sept. 10 – Last names N-S** students register in their homerooms. **Please bring your EHS and EMBI fees. Fees are due today.**

**Sept. 11- Last names T-Z** students register in their homerooms. **Please bring your EHS and EMBI fees. Fees are due today.**
