

TUITION FEES FOR RESIDENT STUDENTS

Background

The Director may consider payment of tuition fees to educational agencies on behalf of resident students enrolled in certain educational programs.

Procedures

1. Tuition fee payments may be made to other non-provincial school divisions or private institutions on behalf of resident students for whom a suitable program is not available within the Division. The principal and Director must determine that the student will benefit from an alternate program of studies.
2. Students may be eligible to attend schools in Manitoba as part of the Inter-provincial agreement between the Governments of Saskatchewan and Manitoba. In such case, the Division shall make payment in accordance with the agreed upon rate subject to completion of the Inter-provincial transfer form approved by both the sending and receiving boards.
3. No tuition fee payments are made to other Saskatchewan school divisions.
