YRHS Staff, Students & Families,

In the letter dated September 27, 2020, you would have been notified that Yorkton Regional High School Grade 9 to 12 students were tentatively set to resume classes at the school on Monday, October 19.

On Thursday, October 8, Division & School Administration met with individuals from the Saskatchewan Health Authority to confirm the return to school date and plan for a safe transition to the school facility. Public Health has determined that transmission of the COVID-19 virus did not occur at the school therefore the date for students to return has been confirmed as October 19.

To assist with the safe return, Public Health has organized a drive-through mobile testing site for staff and students who would like to be voluntarily tested. This will take place on Tuesday, October 13, 2020 by the loading dock door at the Yorkton Regional High School. Staff and students who are in the following classes will be given priority for the testing, however any student or staff member can be tested:

- Morning Classes
 - Chem 30
 - History 30
 - Pre-Calculus 30
- Afternoon Classes
 - ELA A30
 - History 30

We ask that individuals adhere to the following schedule on October 13:


- 8 am – 10:30 am YRHS Staff and Students in the above-mentioned classes
- 10:30 am – 2 pm Remaining YRHS Staff and Students

Pre-registration is mandatory for the mobile testing. **Registration closes at noon on Monday, October 12.** To register, visit gssd.ca. The form is posted at the top of the webpage.

If your child is under the age of 18, verbal consent from a parent or guardian will be required at the testing site. Please ensure that you bring your health card with you.
