Dear Parent/Guardian,

A case of COVID-19 has been diagnosed in an individual who was in attendance at Yorkdale Central School, in the Grade 5W classroom, on October 7, 8 & 9. We are working closely with Public Health to ensure necessary measures are in place to protect all students.

To minimize further risk of transmission, Public Health has advised that all students in Grade 5W are required to self-isolate. Mandatory remote classes, for students in Grade 5W, will begin on Tuesday, October 20, 2020 until October 23, 2020.

Public Health will be contacting parents/guardians of students and any staff/visitors/volunteers who may have been in **close contact** with the case and providing direction. We continue to remind everyone entering schools to monitor for any signs or symptoms of COVID-19. Refer to the [Daily Self-Assessment Checklist](#).
