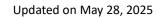

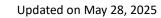

- Classroom Teacher Allocations (Kdn. to Gr. 12)
  - o Classroom teacher numbers are determined using the following:
    - Teacher Allocations (based on GSSD Pupil Teacher Ratio/PTR targets) + Diversity Allocations = The Total Core Classroom Teacher Allocations
  - o These are the expected number of full-time classroom teachers in each school, Kindergarten to Grade 12.
- Total Professional Staffing Allocations
  - The full staffing model—beyond classroom teachers—includes several layers designed to support school leadership, programming, and specialized services.
  - Teacher Allocations Based on PTR + Diversity Allocations + Administrator Allocations (formula-based) + Complexity Teacher Allocations + Prep Time + Student Support Teacher (SST) Allocations + Programming Allocations = The Total Professional Staffing Allocation
- Key Components Explained:
  - Administrator Allocations: Determined by formula based on school enrollment and configuration.
  - Complexity Teacher Allocations (per CBA Article 17):
    - 1.0 FTE for schools with 150+ students
    - o 0.5 FTE for schools with 75–149 students
    - For schools with fewer than 75 students, GSSD provides Low Cushion funding (excluding colony schools) to ensure support despite low enrollment.
  - Prep Time: Allocated as 8% of the total teacher FTE, excluding complexity, administrator, and SST positions. Additional prep., equally 2.6% will be outlined in the 2025-26 calendar.



- Student Support Teachers (SSTs): Allocated at a 1:175 student ratio to support inclusive education and intervention services.
- Programming Allocations include:
  - o Low Cushion or Small School Needs
  - Schools of Necessity (geographic or demographic challenges)
  - Graduation Coaching (based on historic grad rates)
  - o PAA (Practical & Applied Arts) (based on section counts from the previous year)
  - o Innovative Programming (identified in school improvement plans or system initiatives)
- GSSD's staffing process is driven by equity, transparency, and responsiveness. While the foundation is built on standard formulas, layered allocations for complexity, student support, and small schools reflect our commitment to ensuring every student, in every classroom, receives quality instruction—regardless of location or circumstance.
