SECONDARY STUDENT CREDIT REQUIREMENTS

Background

The Division expects that, whenever possible, students at the secondary level shall take the equivalent of eight or more credits in each academic year.

Procedures

- 1. All students in Grades 9-12 are required to develop and maintain graduation and post-graduation plans via the required platform (e.g., myBlueprint) to support their transition through secondary school and beyond.
- 2. The principal, graduation coach, or designate shall monitor the graduation plans and credit attainment of secondary students on an ongoing basis.
- 3. The principal, graduation coach, or designate shall, in consultation with classroom teachers, develop plans to support students in meeting graduation requirements.
