TUITION FEES FOR RESIDENT STUDENTS

Background

The Director may consider payment of tuition fees to educational agencies on behalf of resident students enrolled in certain educational programs.

Procedures

- 1. Tuition fee payments may be made to other non-provincial school divisions or private institutions on behalf of resident students for whom a suitable program is not available within the Division. The principal and Director must determine that the student will benefit from an alternate program of studies.
- 2. Students may be eligible to attend schools in Manitoba as part of the Inter-provincial agreement between the Governments of Saskatchewan and Manitoba. In such case, the Division shall make payment in accordance with the agreed upon rate subject to completion of the Inter-provincial transfer form approved by both the sending and receiving boards.
- 3. No tuition fee payments are made to other Saskatchewan school divisions.
