TUITION FEES

Background

The Division may accept students who are considered to be non-resident and may charge a tuition fee as determined in education service agreements, or in the absence of agreements as calculated based on The Education Act Regulation 20.

Procedures

- 1. Students resident to Saskatchewan but not resident to the Division may be granted permission to attend a Division school upon approval of the Directors of both the sending and receiving school divisions without the exchange of tuition fees
- 2. Students on a one-to-one reciprocal student exchange program may be granted permission to attend a high school program in the Division. If a student from the Division spends an equal period of time at the visitor's school, tuition fees will be waived.
- 3. Students who apply to attend a Division high school who are part of a recognized international exchange program must be granted permission to attend a high school by the Director prior to attending. To be recognized, the exchange program must have Saskatchewan students in placements in foreign countries. Each student attending will be levied a tuition fee of 100% of the Ministry of Education per student recognized rate payable to the school division.
- 4. The Director may grant approval to students who are part of programs other than as indicated above. Each student attending will be levied a tuition fee of 100% of the Ministry of Education per student recognized rate payable to the school division.
- 5. Federally funded students, (who reside on reserve land and therefore are not residents of the Division), will be charged tuition fees in accordance with the signed education service agreement and in the absence of an agreement, in accordance with the Ministry of Education per student recognized rate.
- 6. The Director reserves the right to limit the number of foreign students in the Division or in any one school.
- 7. Transportation fees may apply to non-resident students, including those resident on federal lands.
- 8. Unless otherwise specified in the education service agreements, all fees levied are due and payable prior to the commencement of school and all fees are non-refundable.

- 9. On an annual basis, the Board adopts a schedule of fees to apply to:
 - 9.1 Adult students
 - 9.2 Non-resident students
 - 9.3 Students enrolled in the special programs offered by the Division.
