help engage parents and community members to share responsibility of supporting students with academic achievement and well-being






Engaging Parents & Community Members

- attend open houses and other school events
- create pamphlets
- survey parents
- take photos and videos
- make public service announcements

- email SCC highlights
- include Info in school handbook or create handout
- submit info to school newsletter
- post on social media
- send synervoice messages
- make telephone calls
- volunteer at school
- create an SCC website
- submit info to school website
- post notices

Reporting SCC Operations


