Information for the Board (10 fast facts):

- 1. Colony Locations in GSSD
 - o Clarion Colony- Bear Stream School (located 10 Km south and east of Kamsack.)
 - Enrollment: 9 students in grades 1, 3, 3, 7, 7, 8, 9, 10, and 12.
 - Hofer Colony School (located 6 Km west and south of Norquay.)
 - Enrollment: 8 students in grades K, 1, 1, 2, 3, 3, 4, 6.
 - Silver Stream School (Located 49 Km south and west of Yorkton)
 - Enrollment: 8 students in grades K, 1, 3, 4, 5, 6, 8, 9.
- 2. The Hutterite Colonies have access to technology with a ratio of 1-1. Each Principal/teacher closely monitors technology usage.
- 3. Each physical school is supplied by the Colony, and GSSD provides the Principal/teacher.
- 4. The Colony oversees their own facilities and maintenance.
- 5. Students at Bear Stream have graduation opportunities for both male and female students.
- 6. Students are able to graduate by accessing GSSD DLS courses.
- 7. Silver Stream Colony allows students to exit school in grade 9, dependent on their birthdate.
- 8. GSSD offers professional service providers as needed such as:
 - School Counsellor
 - Speech Language Pathologist
 - Occupational Therapist
 - Educational Psychologist
- 9. Instrumental music is not permitted but singing acapella/choir is allowed.
- 10. The Colonies follow the Saskatchewan Curriculum outcomes except for teaching dinosaurs and evolution. Field trips outside of the Colony are allowed with permission granted from the Colony boss.
