
As the Saskatchewan Teachers' Federation (STF) has announced a full walkout for all STF members on Tues., Jan. 16/24, the Good Spirit School Division (GSSD) is issuing the following directives to address the operational needs for that day:

- STF Members: All GSSD staff who are members of the STF will follow the directives of the Teachers' Federation, including participation in the scheduled walkout.
- Reporting to Work: The following non-STF staff members are required to report for work as usual on Jan. 16/24:
  - GSEC Staff
  - Professional Service Providers (non-STF Members)
  - Bus Garage Staff
  - Administrative Assistants
  - Caretakers
  - Library Technicians
  - Indigenous Community Workers
  - Food Services Assistants
  - Nutrition Workers
  - Security Personnel
- Not Reporting to Work:
  - Educational Assistants will not report to work on Jan.16/24. Instead, they will bank their hours usually worked on this day to be utilized during the 2023-24 school year.
  - Bus Drivers will also not report to work on Jan.16/24.

The above directives are aimed at maintaining essential services and minimizing disruption, while respecting the actions of our STF colleagues. This approach balances operational needs with the realities of the walkout. We recognize the impact of these decisions on various roles and responsibilities within our division. Your understanding and continued dedication to the wellbeing of our school community are greatly appreciated.
