
The Government of Saskatchewan announced that **effective, Friday, September 17**, an interim public health order will be in effect requiring the use of non-medical masks in all indoor public spaces in Saskatchewan. **All Prekindergarten/PPEP to Grade 12 students, all staff, and visitors are required to wear a mask while indoors** at school. Additionally, masks are required for all students and staff when using GSSD transportation. Disposable masks will be available at each school and division facility for those who do not have their own.

Exempt from the masking order will be indoor youth athletics for those under the age of 18 while they are actively engaged in athletic activity. Masking in venues hosting youth athletics will remain required for general entry and exit into the facility, for athletes and spectators. The Division is working closely with East Central Athletics Association to review the current public health order and to determine the best way to implement safety measures while continuing extra-curricular activities.

The GSSD Return to School Handbook and supporting documents will be updated and shared in the coming days. The documentation will reflect the September 15 [Public Health Order](#) regarding mandatory isolation and the [Interim Provincial Mandatory Masking Order](#).

Thank you for your cooperation as we continue to support our learners and work together to keep our school community safe.
