



LARK AGREEMENT (Legal, Appropriate, Responsible, Kind)

One-to-One Learning Devices
Good Spirit School Division No. 204

The students of Melville Comprehensive School will be issued individual devices for the purpose of enhancing learning with technology. Each student in the one-to-one program is expected to follow the Acceptable Use Policy of the Good Spirit School Division in its entirety. They will also be required to sign a LARK agreement, along with their parents.

This LARK agreement is a simplified summary and overview of the three-page AP 140 Acceptable Technology Use Policy drafted by Good Spirit School Division and may be viewed in the "Documents" section on the MCS website ([mcs.gssd.ca](http://www.gssd.ca)) at:

The software, network, e-mail, Internet and all components of information technology supplied on the device by Good Spirit School Division must be used in the following manner:

- **LEGAL:** all software, music and/or games must be downloaded or copied in a legal manner.
- **APPROPRIATE:** all words and images used and viewed must be school appropriate, during both school and home use. If receiving inappropriate materials, the student must report it.
- **RESPONSIBLE:** due care and attention will be taken with the hardware, system files, software and peripherals (power cords, cases) so as to prevent damage.
- **KIND:** the use of the devices must be used as a tool that conveys consideration for the thoughts and feelings of others inside and outside of school as well.
